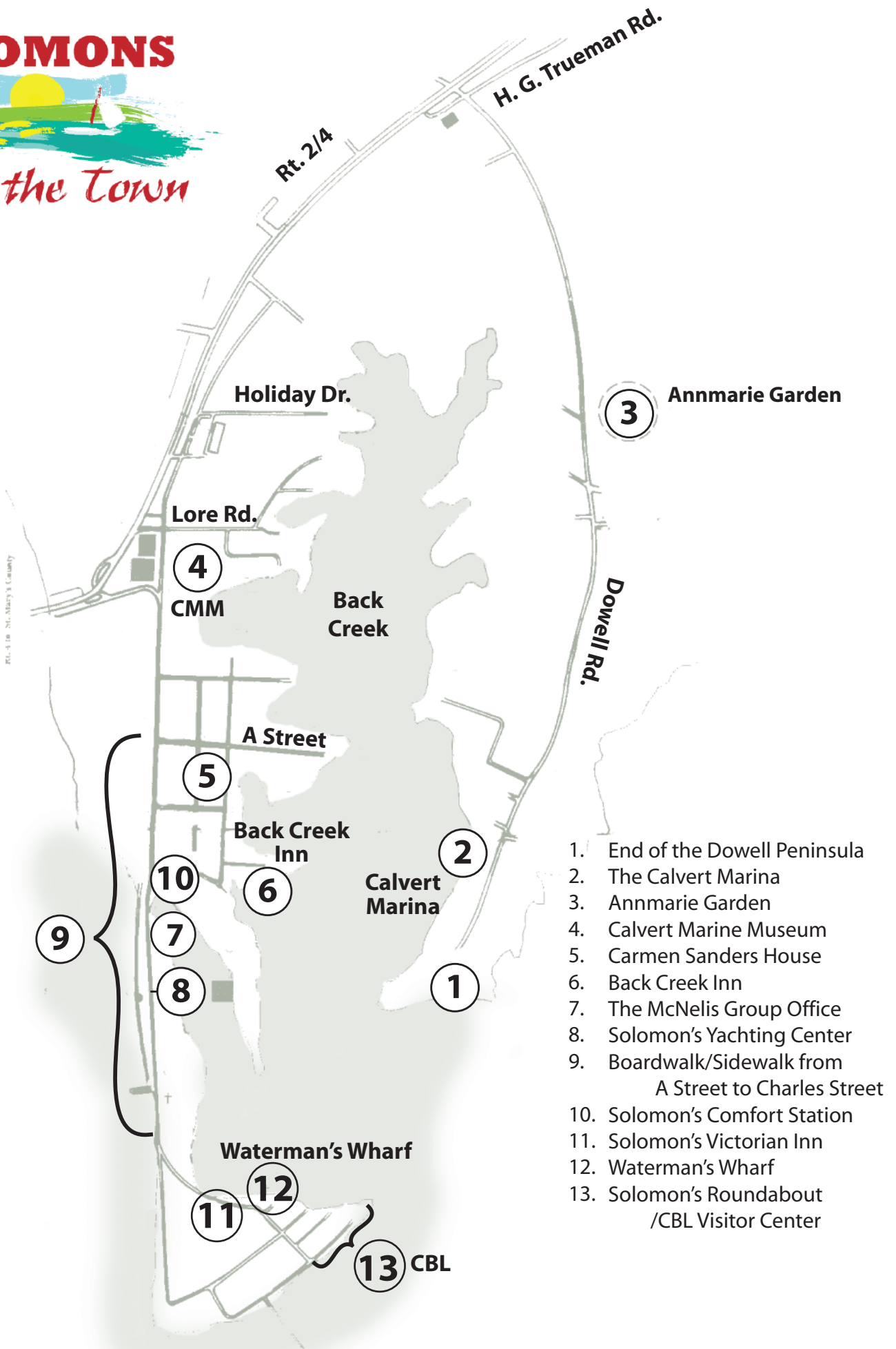

Map Key for Painting Locations: Places Where the Artists Can Be Found

1. **End of the Dowell Peninsula:** Views of the *On Watch* WWII statue, mouth of Mill Creek, Back Creek and Solomons Harbor, Molly's Legg, marinas, Ship's Point
2. **The Calvert Marina:** Views across Back Creek looking toward the Drum Point Lighthouse and Calvert Marine Museum, WWII vintage building housing the Back Creek Bistro, views (from East) Back Bay, Calvert Marina charter boats
3. **Annmarie Garden:** Views of gardens, statuary, water views through the trees, azaleas in full bloom, water views of St. John's Creek through the trees
4. **Calvert Marine Museum:** Drum Point Lighthouse, antique wooden boats, marsh walk, view of Back Creek, view of piers and older waterfront homes
5. **Carmen Sanders House:** artists are invited to set up on the front lawn of house at 14364 Sedwick in Solomons
6. **Back Creek Inn:** Beautiful Garden and restored B&B overlooking Back Creek
7. **The McNelis Group Real Estate Services Office:** artists are welcome to set up on the deck or front yard of The McNelis Group Real Estate Services office at 14488 Solomons Island Road in Solomons
8. **Solomons Yachting Center:** on Jane's Point, waterfront views of Back Creek, Solomons Harbor (Northern view), The Narrows, sail boats, Molly's Legg, fishing fleet
9. **Boardwalk/Sidewalk from A Street to Charles Street:** views (from East) of the Patuxent River, Governor Thomas Johnson Bridge, rowboats on moorings, boats sailing, historic Methodist and Episcopal churches, Solomons Island Yacht Club, J.C. Lore Oyster House, St. Mary's County on opposite shore
10. **Solomons Comfort Station:** Tucked behind the public toilets is a quiet place with transient pier looking over The Narrows and Jane's Point
11. **Solomons Victorian Inn:** artists are invited to paint the fantastic garden and fountain at 125 Charles Street in Solomons.
12. **Waterman's Wharf:** Working waterman's dock, crab pots, oyster and crab boats, view across to On Watch, Solomons Harbor (view from south)
13. **Solomons Roundabout/CBL Visitor Center:** harbor views, best view of the mouth of the Patuxent River, distance view to Drum Point, nesting ospreys, sail boats, historic Solomons House (CBL Visitor Center).
